Hunter Valley, NSW 97 pts James Halliday | 95 |
| 2011 | Tyrrell's Vat 47 Chardonnay

Clare Valley, SA 94 pts James Halliday
<i>This is truly delicious, with fresh and crisp passionfruit and apple blossom aromas, the wine literally dances on the tongue with all the flavours promised by the bouquet.</i> | 69 |
| 2010 | Peppertree Venus Block Chardonnay
Orange, NSW 96 pts James Halliday
<i>Classic, high altitude, Orange region expressiveness of melon, fig and orange blossom, with a restrained and honed finish of purity, fruit focus, structure and minerality.</i> | 85 |
| 2011 | Leconfield Cabernet Sauvignon
Coonawarra, SA 95 pts James Halliday
<i>An attractive medium-bodied cabernet; Coonawarra and McLaren Vale stood out in SA in this vintage, exemplified here by its obviously juicy cassis fruits, in no way obscured by any green or earthy characters. While it will live, there is a strong case for early hedonistic consumption.</i> | 85 |
| 2004 | Mitolo Jester Cabernet Sauvignon
McClaren Vale, SA 91 pts Robert Parker
<i>It is hard to find a better Cabernet than Mitolo's 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon Jester, which spent nine months in used French oak prior to bottling. Approximately 20% of the grapes were dried on racks (a traditional Amarone technique) in order to concentrate the flavour.</i> | 69 |

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- 2011 **Kay Brothers Amery Vineyards Basket Pressed Shiraz** 88
McClaren Vale, SA | 92 pts James Halliday
This is a supple and complex wine, revealing layers of sweet black fruits, fruitcake, vine sap and mocha; the palate is lively and accessible, with a touch of orange rind adding interest; medium-bodied with ample tannins and a moderately long juicy finish.
- 2008 **Mitolo Jester Shiraz** 80
McClaren Vale, SA | 94 pts James Halliday
Power and intensity achieved without reliance on alcohol. Blackberry and a whisper of regional dark chocolate, the tannins are fine, the oak controlled.
- 2010 **Wirra Wirra Woodhenge Shiraz** 68
McClaren Vale, SA | 94 points www.winefront.com.au
Good modern style with fragrant fruit full of silky soft tannins generous middle palate full of regional fruit with dark cherry and blackberry and lick of spice and a soft long finish
- 2010 **Peter Lehmann Drawcard Shiraz** 84
Barossa Valley, SA | 94 pts James Halliday
Vivid and deep purple-crimson; a seriously good wine competing in this high quality battlefield; it hits all the right buttons, with svelte black fruits ranging from black cherry to blackberry on the bouquet and medium- to full-bodied palate, where precisely weighted tannins and oak chime in.
- 2010 **Clonakilla Hilltops Shiraz** 84
Hilltops, NSW | 94 pts James Halliday
Full red-purple, not star-bright; the bouquet is complex, with warm spices threaded through dark cherry and blackberry fruit, the medium- to full-bodied palate with ripe fruit complemented by firm tannins and quality oak. Picked just before heavy rain.
